The 14 video vignettes on MET CBT Plus are designed to support training and clinical supervision in Motivational Enhancement Therapy (MET) and Cognitive Behavior Therapy (CBT) intervention models.

- Videos use a combination of skills demonstration, bulleted key information, and oral narration.
- Videos demonstrate both the effective and ineffective ways of using the skills.
- · "Skills in Action" videos begin by teaching core elements of Motivational Interviewing.
- The videos proceed to demonstrate the integration of MI into the delivery of Cognitive Behavior Therapy and illustrate how to do good structured intervention.
